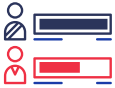


KANSAS: ARE YOU READY TO VOTE?



ELECTION DAY IS NOVEMBER 3RD!



Advance Voting, In-Person: All counties must offer advance in-person voting by October 27th, but can start as early as October 14th. The deadline for advance in-person voting is 12:00 pm on November 2, 2020. Vote at your local election office or a satellite location. Check with your county election office for details.

Advance Voting, By Mail: You must fill out an application to receive an advance ballot by mail. The advance voting ballot application must be submitted by October 27th, 2020 for the general election. Ballots must be postmarked on or before election day and received by the county election office by close of business day November 6th.

In Person Voting November 3rd, Tips to review before election day!

1. Confirm your polling place <https://myvoteinfo.voteks.org/voterview>
2. Polls open at 6 a.m. and close at 7 p.m. If you are in line at 7 p.m. **YOU CAN VOTE!**
3. Bring proper Identification. <https://kssos.org/elections/photo-id.html>
4. Know your rights. Polling places are required to be accessible to all voters. Disabled voters may ask assistance from a friend, family member, or polling place worker. It never hurts to contact your local voting authority in advance to ask about voting accommodations. Visit [ACLU.ORG](https://aclu.org) for a list of your full voting rights.
